

# International Programs

One of the world's largest scholarship administrators, Scholarship America (SAI) combines best-in-class service with a nonprofit mission. On behalf of our sponsors, we administer 150+ international programs each year.

## Case Study: Children of Employees Scholarship

Scholarship America administers an international scholarship program on behalf of a global logistics company ("Company") with 500,000+ employees in 200+ countries and territories. The goal of the program is to assist dependent children of current employees—many of whom are hourly workers—pursue higher education.

### Background

Scholarship America has administered a domestic scholarship program for the Company since 1983, and contracted to administer the corresponding global scholarship in 2014.

Like the Company's domestic program, the international program awards scholarships to dependents of full-time and part-time current employees who have completed one year of employment. The international program is specifically for employees whose payroll is processed outside the United States.

### Reaching Students

To provide flexibility and ensure maximum reach to students in need, eligible applicants also include the dependents of:

- + Employees whose time with the Company includes approved leaves of absence, with or without compensation.
- + Employees whose death occurred while the employee was employed full-time or part-time.
- + Retired employees whose retirement began after the application deadline.
- + Those employed regular full-time or part-time by a subsidiary.

### Results and Impact

Up to 100 awards of \$2,500 (USD) each are given each year, and recipients can renew their scholarships for up to three years or until a bachelor's degree is earned, whichever occurs first, provided they maintain a satisfactory grade-point average and full-time enrollment.

Since contracting with Scholarship America in 2014, the program has provided over **\$3.3 million in renewable scholarships to more than 400 students in 40 countries, including Singapore and the U.K.**
